Call for Interactive Tutorials

The workshop cordially invites researchers to submit tutorials that leverage analysis tools to study some form of continuous-event neural data (e.g., speech or music listening). Selected tutorials will be presented in a dedicated time-slot (max duration 2h). The presenter will also have the opportunity to showcase their work (e.g., a scientific finding with their method) in a dedicated 20 min presentation. The talks and interactive tutorials will take place on the second day of the workshop, **Tuesday, July 19, 2022**.

We encourage researchers in their graduate and postdoctoral stages of their career to submit a tutorial abstract (max 250 words and 1 figure). The tutorial must use publicly available toolboxes and data sets. We also ask that the tutorial itself be implemented in an interactive manner e.g., MATLAB Live Script, Python-based Google Colaboratory, Jupyter Notebook. Your tutorial abstract should include a high level description of the method, a description of the proposed tutorial structure and goals, as well as up to three relevant publications. Three tutorials will be selected from your submissions.
