Call for Project Proposals

The CNSP Organizing Committee invites researchers to submit project proposals involving the study of continuous-event neural data (e.g. speech or music listening experiments). PhD students and postdoctoral researchers with any degree of experience in the CNSP field are encouraged to apply. The research proposal may involve re-analysing existing data, either publicly available or from your own lab, as well as a novel experiment, including data collection (at your own institution or at a participating institution of your choice). Any dataset used as part of this research will be released at the end of the project (with some exceptions if necessary, e.g. clinical data). We ask that only one proposal is submitted per applicant.

The awardee will receive a travel grant (up to €1500) to perform the research (or parts of it) as a visiting researcher in 2024. Work needs to be completed by the end of the summer of 2024. This travel award will be generously provided by our sponsor, mBrainTrain (https://mbraintrain.com). The project can be conducted at any participating institution, with the understanding that the awardee and host will use this opportunity to support the CNSP initiative and open science in general (e.g. data sharing on the CNSP platform). Proposals may describe projects that will be completed during the research stay as well as projects that will be only partly carried out during the research stay.

Proposals should not exceed 500 words. Submissions will be reviewed by a panel composed of the CNSP organizers and keynote speakers. Research proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Intellectual merit of proposed idea
- Feasibility
- Applicant's qualifications and track record
